Extract (translated from the Hebrew) from the Statutes of Wahat al Salam~ Neve Shalom Registered 1984

Authorised by the Ministry of Interior Registration number 58-007-561-2

Aims

- a) Neve Shalom ~ Wahat al Salam is an Arab-Jewish village founded in 1970 near Latrun. The residents are Palestinians and Jewish, citizens of Israel, who have chosen to create a shared community which aims to challenge existing relations between Arabs and Jews. The community strives to establish an egalitarian model which breaks down social barriers which prevail in Israeli society.
- b) The establishment of public educational and cultural institutions including the establishment of a primary school and a school for peace and institutions for cultural activities with the aim to promote goals of the organization in general and to promote the idea of peace in particular.
- c) To establish a centre for the three monotheistic largest religions (Jewish, Christian and Moslem)

A full version of the Statues of Wahat al Salam ~ Neve Shalom is available in Hebrew. It was first written in 1984 and most recently modified in 2004.
